AGENDA ITEM 1: Online Student Representation

- C. Everdell explained that online students will be paying SSAF next year and the current SRC constitution allows elections to be conducted for an online campus committee.

- Discussion:
 - o P. Taylor acknowledged that online students should be involved in the SRC if they are paying SSAF.
 - o A. Willis asked what online students can get out of the opportunity. Opportunities include being able to assist the SRC identify a wider range of services that can cater to online students, Micro credential (badge), experience on the board

AGENDA ITEM 2: SRC Constitution

- C.Everdell explained the process of altering the SRC constitution and asked the board to consider whether they are ready to vote on the constitutional changes.
- The board agreed to not vote on a new constitution to allow more time for representatives to understand the changes and to consult with the student body before going to a referendum and University Council.

Other Business

- Public Transport Concessions
 - o P. Taylor raised the issue of Translink advising Universities to alter eligibility requirements for concession fairs which may cause some students to lose their concessions.
 - o Board agreed to advocate for more services on a more regular basis for Griffith Campuses (such as Logan, Nathan) because they aren't on the main public transport lines.
- Government Reforms for University Funding
 - o P. Taylor reminded the board of the draft statement that has been created with regards to the Government reforms to Universities. Encouraged board members to give their feedback before circulation to the student body.
- Review of Freedom of Speech in Australian Higher Education Providers
 - o C.Everdell circulated a request from Professor (Emeritus) Sally Walker regarding an Independent Review of the Adoption of the Model Code on Freedom of Speech and Academic Freedom. SRC to provide feedback by 30th September.
